

Remains of Missing Western Washington Woman ID'd 20 Years Later

Wahkiakum County officials have identified human remains originally discovered in 2021 as a woman who went missing 20 years before.

The remains have been identified as those of 39-year-old Susan Lynn Ault, who vanished from the Rosburg area in 2001, according to a press release.

Ault's case has been reclassified to a homicide, after being listed as a missing person all these years.

To identify the remains, the Wahkiakum County Sheriff's Office obtained a [DNA sample](#) of Ault's daughter.

Wahkiakum County Coroner Dan Bigelow said in the press release state in the press release that "these findings do not end the investigation into her disappearance, but at least we can put to rest some doubts for her family and friends."
